Arbor Circle's vision is to transform the lives of children, adults, and families facing mental health, substance use and family concerns in a caring partnership with our clients and diverse community. They are proud to be one of West Michigan's most comprehensive providers of mental health counseling, substance use treatment and family services.



Information from the Newaygo office's staff:

Arbor Circle of Newaygo works with persons with substance use disorders and opioid use disorders by providing them with outpatient counseling, as well as providing counseling for other co-occurring mental health disorders. They also have a Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program where a doctor comes in twice a week to provide clients with Suboxone for OUD. Newaygo's office plans to start working closely with Newaygo county jail to help individuals that are in need of Suboxone, as well as help prepare individuals getting ready to leave the jail by providing them with resources to get some of Arbor Circles services.

Arbor Circle also has a recovery coach to help clients, as well as case management services specific to women. Arbor Circles staff provides in-person services as well as some tele-health services. They also work with referrals from schools and other agencies, and provide other resources for clients who need more than what Arbor Circle can offer. They also accept medicare, medicaid, and most insurances.
