Angels of Action runs The HUB (Helping, Uniting, Bridging) -- Families can utilize this program for help with basic necessities (food/hygiene/clothing), navigation of homelessness & housing needs, referrals to other resources and organizations, etc.

The HUB is a 3-fold program with the initiative to reduce barriers that families face when seeking support in times of need. They are a guiding hand for families in need to help receive assistance in resource connections and referrals in the community. Their goal is to direct families to services that meet their needs. Sometimes the missing piece is a phone call from one organization to another, showing that the family is taking the steps necessary to help themselves. Building relationships and following up is an important focus of the HUB. They encourage and support families through the process of receiving help; building trust is vital to be able to identify and address the underlying needs of the family.

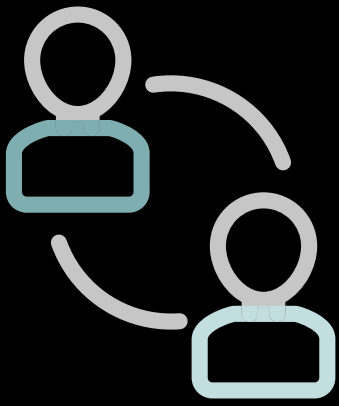
