Central Michigan District Health Department runs the Exchange Central Syringe Service Program - which is a safe and confidential program that makes sterile syringes accessible to those who use drugs. Their program aligns with an evidence-based public health service shown to reduce the spread of HIV and Hepatitis C. They also offer a place to connect with other resources for needs such as treatment, testing, overdose prevention, and medication. CMDHD does not require any information from people in need other than a first name and phone number, just to allow for a form of communication.

CMDHD is specifically trained to counsel, educate, and test for HIV and Hepatitis C by using 20 minute rapid testing. They are also phlebotomy trained to perform conventional blood draws. They have a full STD clinic where they can test and treat for other STDs right at their health department, as well as a PrEP clinic, and a clinic for those living with HIV.

They have two full-time staff members who are state certified disease intervention specialists who assist linkage for treatment and resources for those positive and for partners of those positive for HIV or syphilis. They are currently in the process of making their services mobile to increase accessibility!
